All you have to do is fill out this Entry Form and submit it along with a \$5 entry fee (Cash) by 11 am on Saturday, September 24, 2011 and come to eat ten Egg Rolls as fast as you could possibly eat.



The Rules

- ✓ Must be 15 years of age or older to enter. Under 18 years of age, Contestant's parent/guardian must sign along with the Contestant.
- ✓ \$5 Entry Fee.
- ✓ Entry is limited to the first 20 applicants.
- ✓ Contestants may not touch the Egg Rolls until the starting signal.
- ✓ Only entire Egg Roll eaten will be counted.
- ✓ Contestants will have 10 Egg Rolls to the fastest time.
- ✓ Contestants may drink bottled water provided by organizer while eating the Egg Rolls.
- ✓ Partially eaten Egg Rolls will not be counted.
- ✓ The time will stop when the last of 10-Egg Rolls is completely to swallow and no contents remaining in contestant's mouths.
- ✓ Visible signs of sickness will result in disqualification by UCAF's Medical Advisory Team.

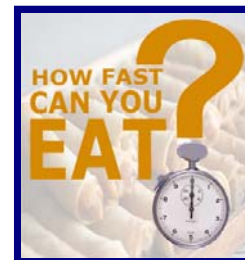

Egg Rolls Eating Contest – Entry Form & Rules

9th Annual UCAF's Egg Rolls Eating Contest 2011

- What:** To win this competition and claim the honor of 2011 UCAF's Egg Rolls Eating Champion. The contestants must eat ten (10) Egg Rolls at his/her fastest time possible.
- Where:** The official UCAF's Egg Rolls Eating Table at the Center Performance Stage of the annual South Florida Dragon Boat Festival.
- When:** 1:00 pm Saturday, September 24, 2011



Eligibility:

Contest is open to all residents 15 years old or older.

To Enter:

\$5 Entry Fee. Limited number contestants available. Read carefully the official contest Rules and Entry Form. The UCAF's Egg Rolls Eating Contest including the eligibility requirements and waiver of liability provisions. Complete and sign the Egg Rolls Eating Contest Entry Form. All entry forms become the property of United Chinese Association of Florida.

The Rules:

- ✓ Contestants may not touch the Egg Rolls until the starting signal.
- ✓ Only entire Egg Roll eaten will be counted.
- ✓ Contestants will have 10 Egg Rolls to the fastest time.
- ✓ Contestants may drink bottled water provided by Organizer while eating their Egg Rolls.
- ✓ Partially eaten Egg Rolls will not be counted.
- ✓ The time will stop when the last of 10th Egg Rolls is completely to swallow and no contents remaining in contestant's mouths.
- ✓ Visible signs of sickness will result in disqualification by UCAF's Medical Advisory Team.



Prize Awards:

Prize will be awarded to the fastest finisher.

All Contestants must read and sign the Entry Form & Rules before entering:

- ✓ Eating large amounts of Egg Rolls is a potentially hazardous and uncomfortable activity. You should not enter and eat unless you are medically capable and properly trained. All contestants must understand and agree that this is all in good fun, and possibly bad taste, and to be a good sport.
- ✓ All contestants agree to abide by any decision of the contest officials and any and all of contest rules.
- ✓ All contestants acknowledges that they assume all risks associated with eating in this event including, but not limited to, indigestion, that stuffed feeling, contact with other contestants, a general dislike for Egg Rolls after he/she is done, and all risks of personal injury, illness and possible loss of life, and risks of damage to or loss of personal property. Contestant, and anyone entitled to act on the contestant's behalf, agrees to waive and release United Chinese Association of Florida and all affiliated persons, entities, and groups, their vendors, their advertising, promotion and public relations agencies, co-sponsoring companies and their affiliates and agencies, from any and all claims or liabilities of any kind arising out of his/her participation in this event.
